RESOLVED: The Parish Council to submit the following comment to Cheshire East Planning:

Hankelow Parish Council does not support this application, due to the current positioning of the proposed Garden Shed and on the grounds already stipulated in the previous application (23/3455N). While this new application proposes slight modifications in length and height (mainly due to excavation of the ground below the structure), it does not sufficiently address the original concerns. There remains uncertainty about the distance between the boundary fence and the structure (not specified in the plans and may not comply with planning standards due to unclear measurements and positioning) and does not address any compromises excavation may have on the integrity and structure of the boundary fences.
