6.1 CEC Local Plan

7 TRAFFIC ASSESSMENT OF ROADS IN THE PARISH

The Clerk overlooked this matter, but has now put in a request for an assessment of the roads in the parish. This has been forwarded to the Traffic and Road Safety Team for consideration. The Clerk expects to be able to report to the meeting.

8 DOG-WASTE BIN – MONKS LANE

The Chairman requested the inclusion of this item on the agenda following reports of an on-going problem with dog-faeces being left on a bench on Monks Lane.

The Clerk has asked if Cheshire East Council (through ANSA) can provide such bins.

ANSA is unable to provide a bin free-of-charge; moreover, even if the Parish Council had funds to purchase a bin, ANSA could not add collection of waste onto its waste-collection round as Monks Lane is an unsuitable road for the refuse-collection vehicle as the lane is only one-vehicle wide.
